Supporting St Matthew's School Cyangugu Rwanda



The school is owned by the Diocese of Cyangugu, which is responsible for providing the buildings, teachers and equipment. The Nursery School opened in 1999, the Primary department was built in 2002 and the school extended to include a College providing education up to the age of 14 in 2010.



The school has a Christian ethos and is locally well known for its high standards of education and exam results.

The School is open to all children. However, many children who attend are unable to pay the school fees as their families have little or no income.

The sponsorship programme supports the whole school, helping to pay the staff salaries. This central funding simplifies our support for the growing number of disadvantaged children attending as the school expands.

Staff

The Head teacher of St Matthew's School and College is Neza Kenneth.
The Nursery School has three classroom teachers and two assistants.
The Primary School has six classroom teachers.
The College has three classroom teachers and assistants.
There are two caretakers.

As the sponsorship is intended to help pay the staff salaries for a full academic year (January - December) we ask for the full sum irrespective of when the Sponsorship is taken out.
